












PZ #2 Driver bit (Supplied)






PZ #2 Screwdriver (Not supplied)




Construction Notes:

- 1) Wear gloves during construction to avoid injury when handling panels
- 2) Please leave yourself plenty of workspace to assemble
- 3) Do not build on a hard surface as this might damage the panels during construction
- 4) Whether you have the center unit only or the center + side units, the construction method is the same across all modules




Ensure clamping dowels are completely inserted before dowel screw is screwed in
